- The candidates are requested to go through the said detailed recruitment notification, available in the department website viz https://tnincometax.gov.in/ for eligibility, selection procedure and other conditions before filling the application.
- Please ensure that all the relevant documents are readily available in softcopy in the prescribed format before filling application.
- In the online Application Form, candidates are required to upload the scanned passport size photograph with full name and date on which photograph was taken in JPEG/png/jpg format. The photograph should not be more than three months old from the date of publication of the Notice of Examination. The photograph should be without cap, spectacles and both ears should be visible. Applications with poor quality, miniature and blurred photographs/ side facing photographs will be rejected. **Please see the sample photographs before you upload the same.**
- Scanned signature in JPEG/JPG/PNG format. Candidate has to sign in a white page with black pen and the scan the same, crop it to the extant of the signature and then upload the same. Applications with blurred signature will be rejected. For PwD or PwBD candidate with blindness and low vision, thumb impression is also allowed in the place of signature. **Please see the sample signatures before you upload the same.**

- **Sl.No.12** Please enter the details of educational qualification of **Matriculation or equivalent exam**.
